Eltville City Tours

1 | Eltville's historic Old Town

Stroll through the idyllic Old Town of the Wine, Sekt (sparkling wine) and Rose City Eltville, characterized by its harmonic ensemble of half-timbered structures, picturesque homes of the upper class and magnificent aristocratic estates as well as one of the most beautiful Rhine River promenades in the entire Rheingau region.

Duration: 1.5 hours or 2 hoursPrice per group: 85 euros or 105 euros

2 | The Electors' Castle

On your tour through the tower of Eltville's historic landmark from 14th century you will discover different rooms and chambers on each floor: from the dungeon to the count's hall, from the Gutenberg exhibit to the capitular chamber where a small art exhibit displays works of local artists. Finally you reach the panorama platform which offers a beautiful view over Eltville and the Rhine river. Afterwards the guide will take you on a relaxed stroll through the magnificent rose garden adjacent to the castle.

3 | In Gutenberg's Footsteps

Eltville is one of the oldest printing sites in the world. The "black art" made its entrance already during the lifetime of Henne Gensfleisch, historically known as Johannes Gutenberg, the inventor of movable type for the printing press. Gutenberg helped the Bechtermünz brothers print a Latin dictionary that was published in Eltville in 1467. He received the only honor of his lifetime in the Electors' Castle in the year 1465 when the title of nobleman was conferred on him by the Elector Adolf of Nassau. During this tour you will search for traces of Gutenberg and will learn interesting facts about his life and work.

4 | Eltville - Rose City

At the end of the 19th century Eltville was already much talked about as a "rose city." Today over 22,000 rose bushes in 350 different varieties, many of them rarities and vintage species, bloom in the rose garden of the Electors' castle and on public grounds. If you would like to learn more about the history of Eltville and its roses, you can join us on a tour from the Old Town to the rose beds along the banks of the Rhine and on to the Electors' Castle with its rose garden. You'll be enchanted by the fragrant sea of blossoms. (The main flowering season is from May through July.)

5 | Old Town Tour with Sekt

Begin your tour with a zesty aperitif or enjoy a glass of Sekt (sparkling wine) after your classic Old Town tour while lingering within the historical walls of the Electors' Castle.

Here you will learn everything about the process of wine production - from the grape to the bottle. The expert tour of the cellars includes three top-class wines from the best wineries.
